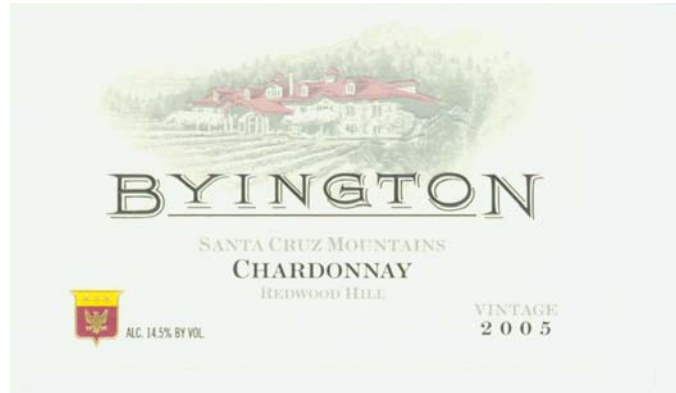


COLLECTOR'S WHITE

Redwood Hill's tiny little one acre property produced an astounding harvest in 2005, over six tons, all outstanding quality fruit . The vineyard is truly a little piece of heaven, bordered by seven acres of gorgeous gardens, an apple orchard, a pear orchard, and a stand of old growth redwoods. The owners, the doctors Barber, practice sustainable growing practices as they manage their vineyard.

This wine is barrel fermented in French Oak which gives a vanilla kiss to the mineral backbone of this classic Santa Cruz Mountains Chardonnay. The Redwood Hill has a delicate apple nose, perhaps from that nearby apple orchard, and a lovely, crisp acidity. This is an outstanding food wine and pairs perfectly with a broad range of cuisines— but it shines with cheeses. This Chardonnay is drinking well now, but should continue to evolve until next winter.
