Once again the Liage is what we expect — crisp, clean, and full of flavor. The 2007 Liage is made of Sauvignon Blanc from Ventana Vineyard and the Viognier is from Lodi this year which is something new for this blend. Lodi being known for its hot climate produces wines with an intense fruity aroma and Viognier, being known for its tropical nose, is a perfect match for the ripe Lodi soil.

Take in the full aroma of the Liage, guava and banana come to the forefront. On the palate enjoy the contrasts of mouth feel, the acidity from the Sauvignon Blanc and the unctuous mouth feel resulting from the Viognier. The two intertwine in an elegant fashion creating this wonderfully drinkable wine.
