



**Appellation:** Sonoma Mountain

Once again, Van der Kamp vineyard, on Sonoma Mountain, has produced an eloquent and an undeniably fantastic wine. This year, we received only two tons of fruit—and we were quite lucky to even receive that much—but, as you can see, the 2005 Van der Kamp Pinot Noir has developed into a full-bodied, well-balanced wine.

The wine has incredible depth—from the first sniff to the last drop. It was a pleasure sampling the wine for the juniper notes, backed by the aroma of wild sage and forest floor. As the wine passes your lips, you get an image in your mind that only each individual can describe: picture relaxing with friends and family on a beautiful summer evening with this lovely bottle of Pinot, paired with something simple from the grill. Dark, rich fruit dances across your palette with spicy undertones carrying through its long finish.

With only 99 cases left, this wine will not stick around long. This special Pinot was a joy to make—a small batch, but with tons of potential.
